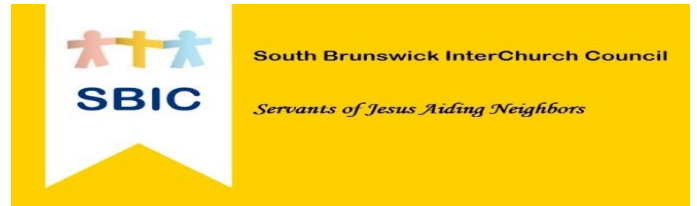

Providing Help and Hope Since 1981

PORCH – The Lords Food Pantry received 1,920 pounds of food in November from the PORCH collection.

Grants – Received \$2,500 from the Town of Shallotte; \$1,250 from NCCF; and \$1,250 from Granville Capital, Inc., this month.

Healthy Opportunities Pilot Program (HOP)

We delivered 31 HOP boxes in November.

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

In November, we served 57 families, or 193 individuals (55 children, 74 adults, and 64 seniors).

Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP)

We received 70 boxes in November. We distributed all 70 boxes on November 12.

Brunswick Wellness Coalition Steps Up

We are periodically receiving Brunswick Wellness Coalition food boxes (similar to Senior boxes) and are receiving produce at the Food Bank through this program.

Thanksgiving/Christmas Dinner Boxes

The SBIC packed 150 Thanksgiving Dinner Boxes on Friday, November 18 and will pack 140 Christmas Dinner Boxes on Friday, December 16.
